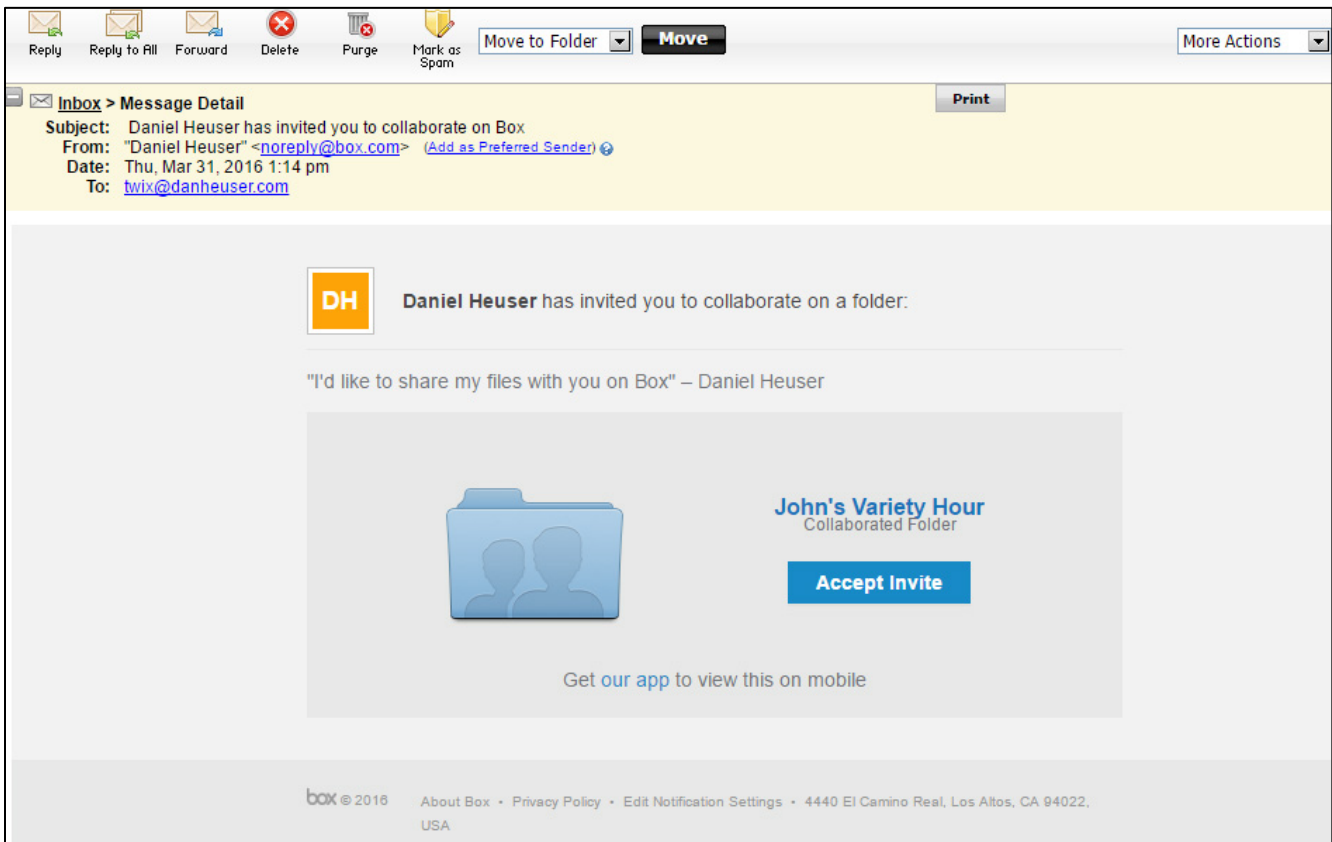
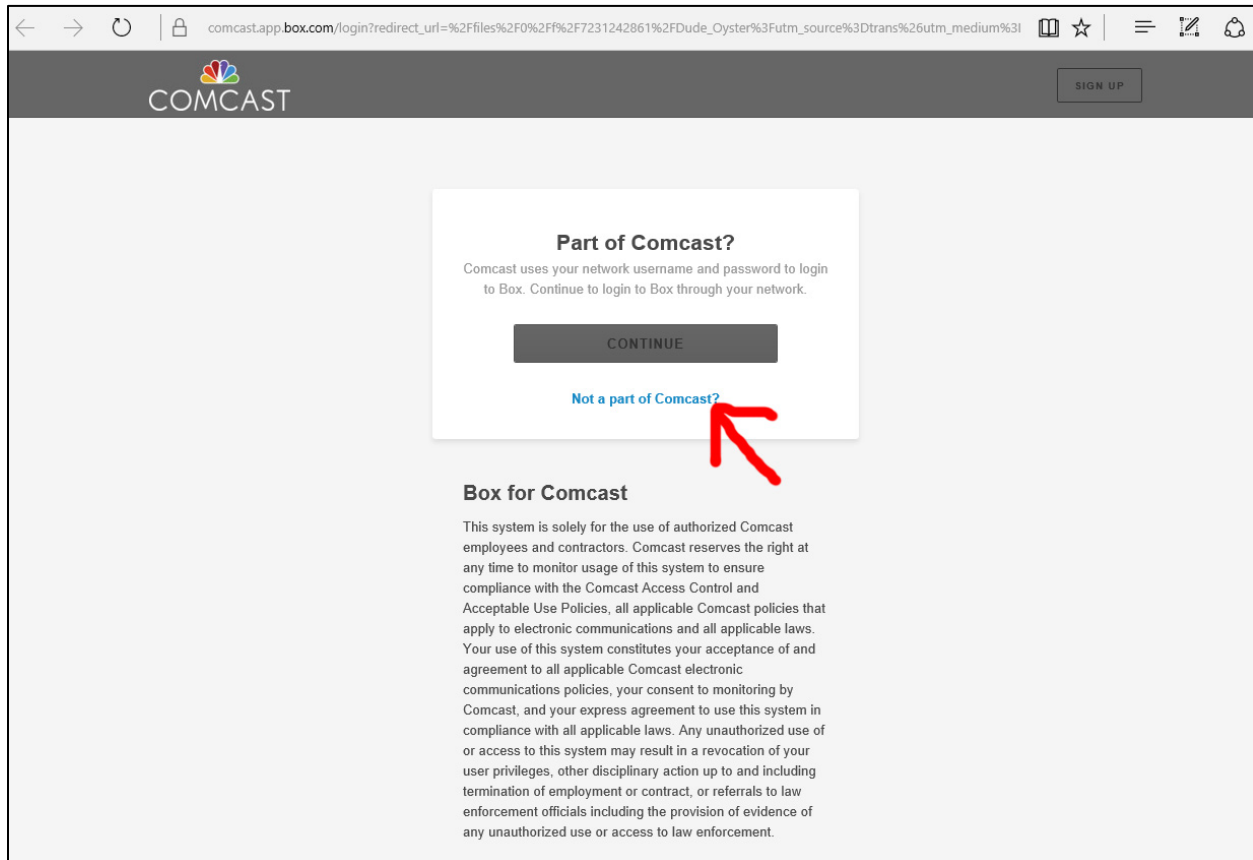


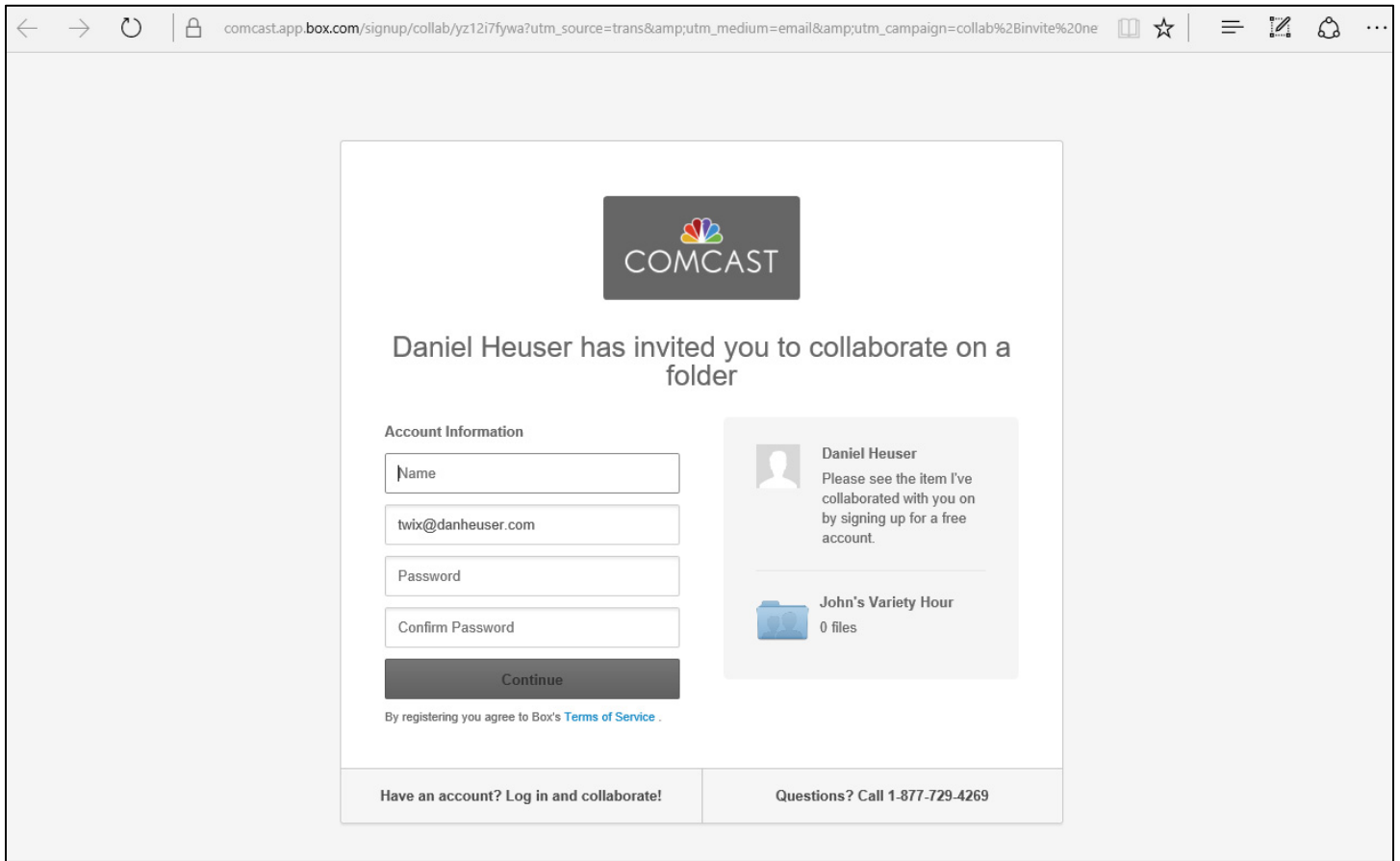
1. You will receive an email invitation to collaborate on your show folder. Click on the “Accept Invite” button.



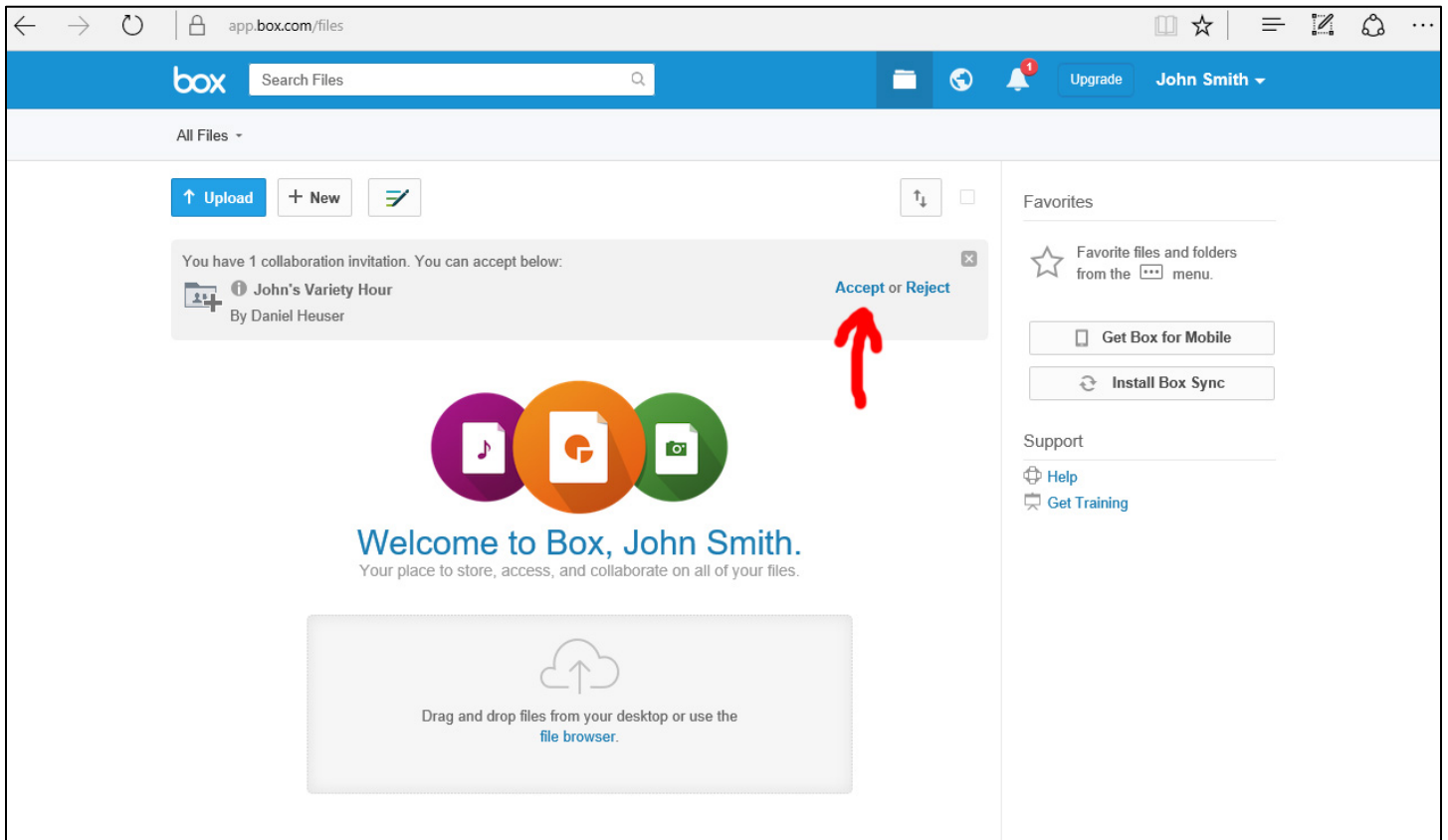
2. The next screen will ask if you are part of Comcast. **DO NOT** hit the “Continue” button. This login method is for Comcast employees only. Click on “Not Part of Comcast?” link right below.



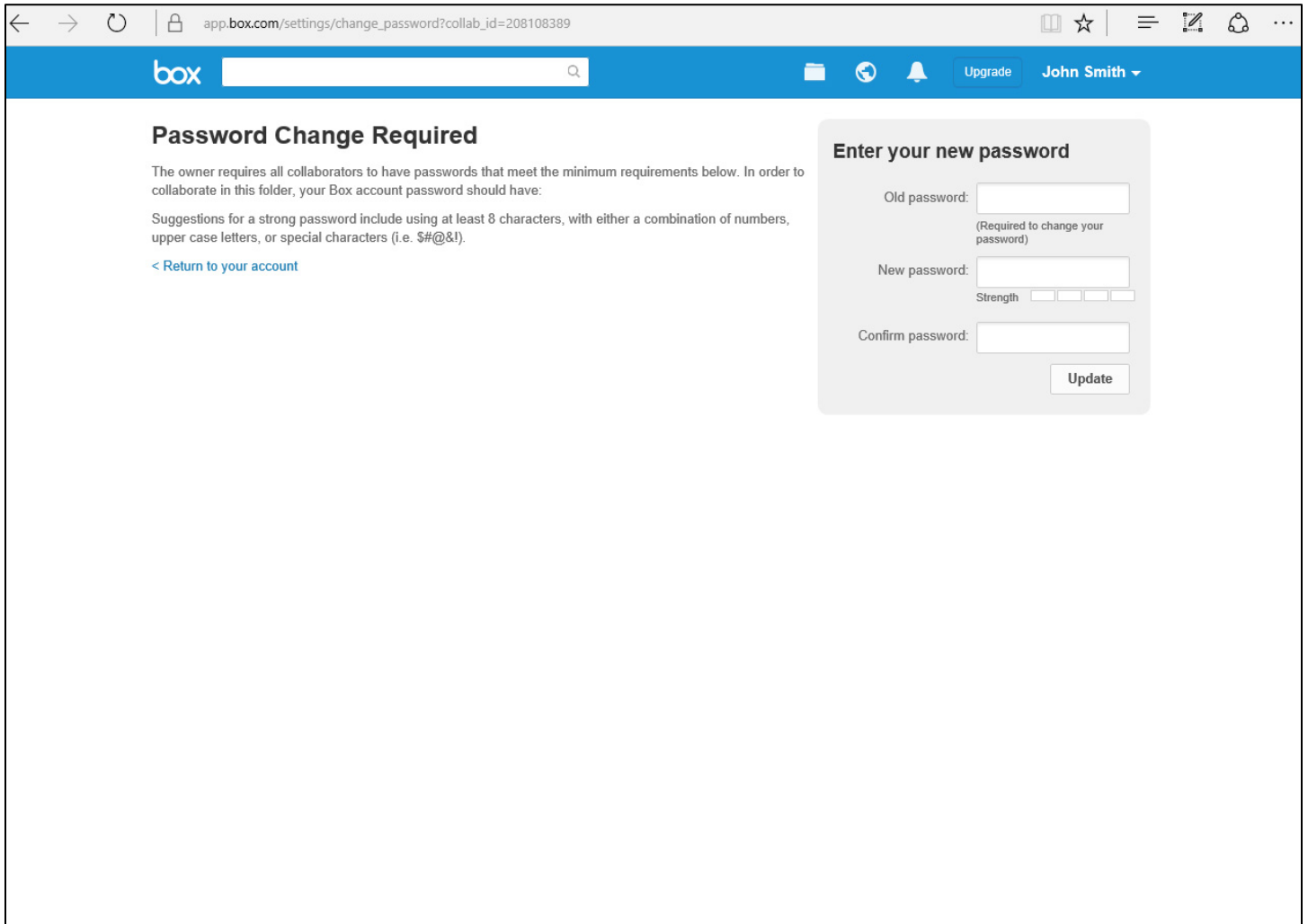
3. The next screen will prompt you to create an account with a name, email and password.



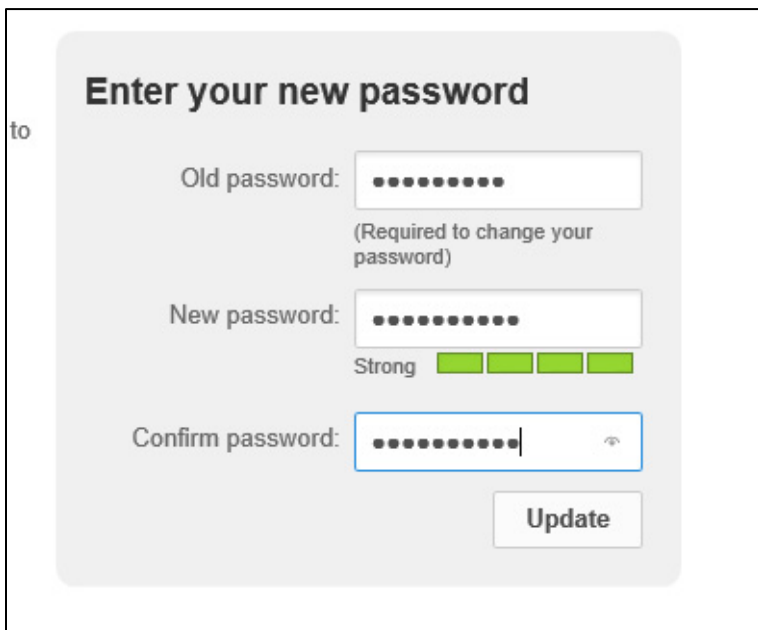
4. Once your account is created, you will have to accept the invitation on your folder in order to start using it.



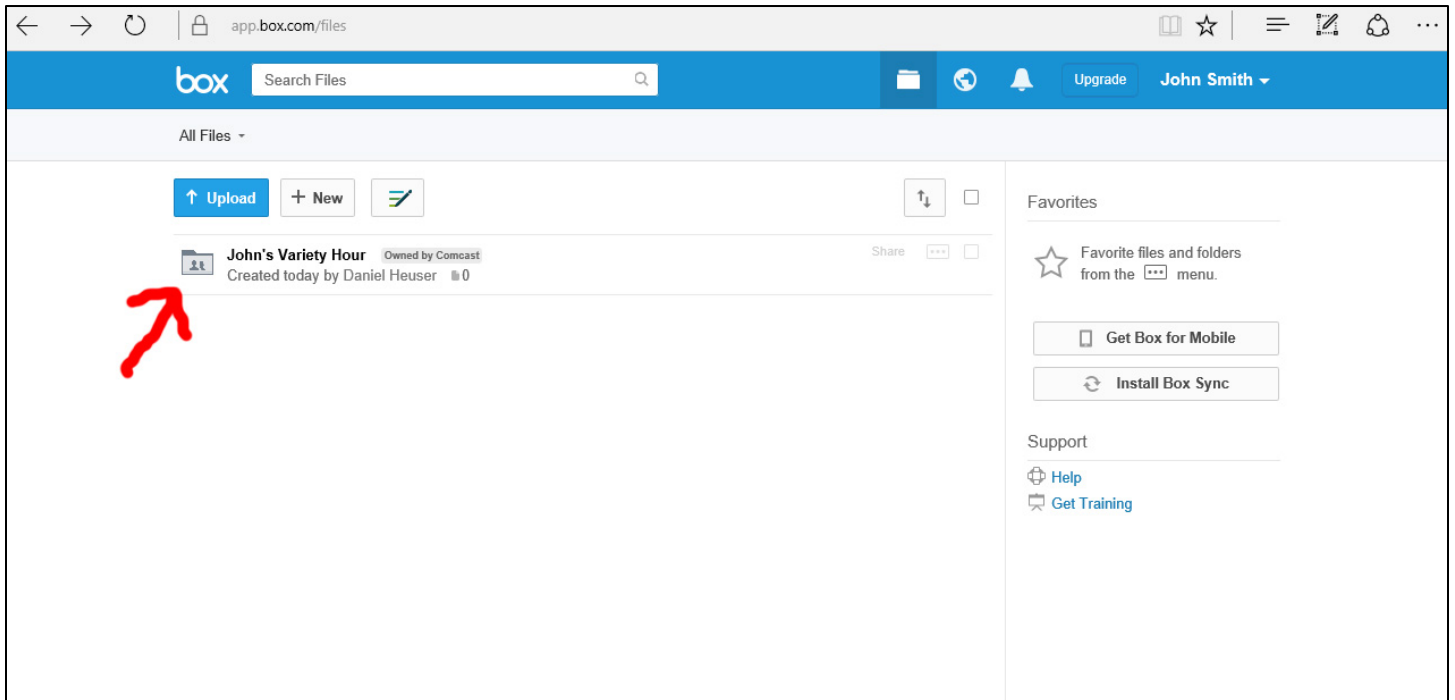
5. Collaborating on a folder with Comcast requires you to have a strong password. If the password you've selected is not identified as "Strong", then it will give you this prompt to change your password. Follow the directions on the screen to come up with a strong password.



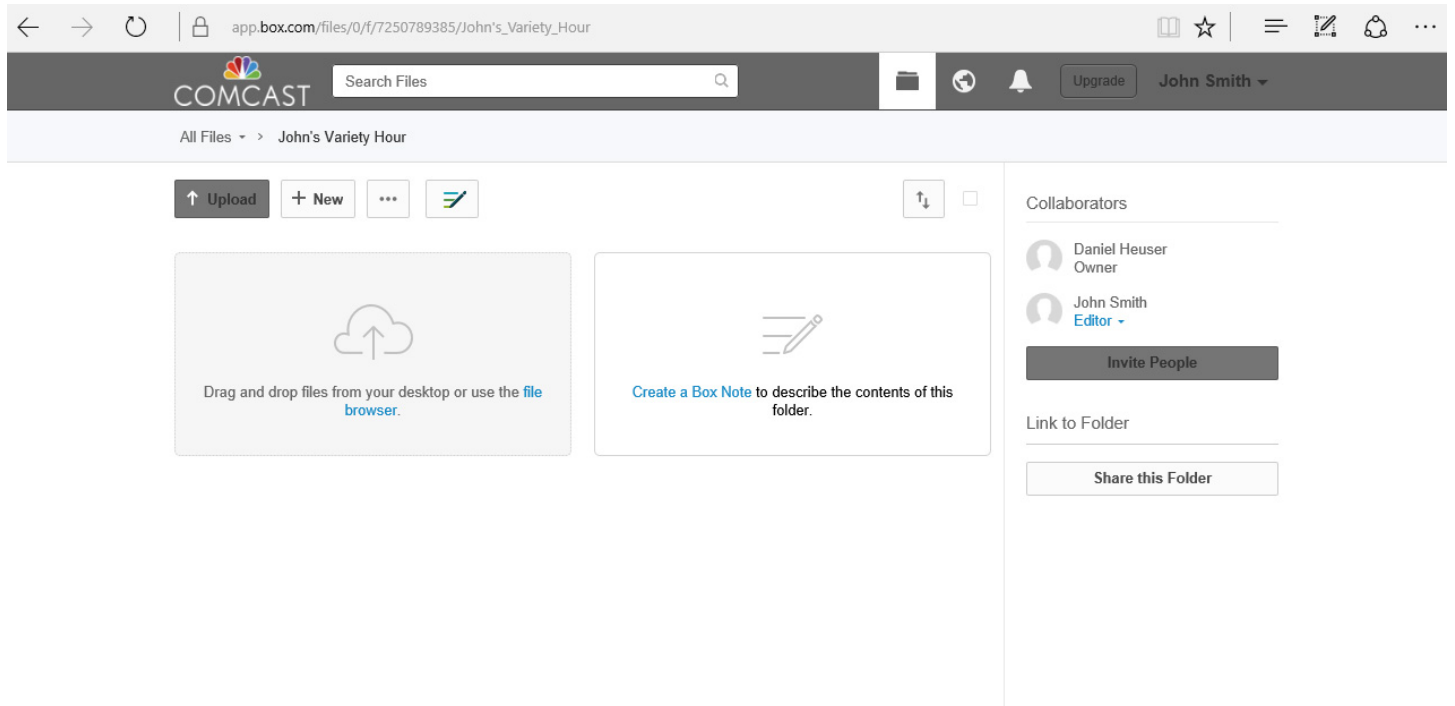
6. When your new password is identified as "Strong", type it again in the field below it and then press "Update".



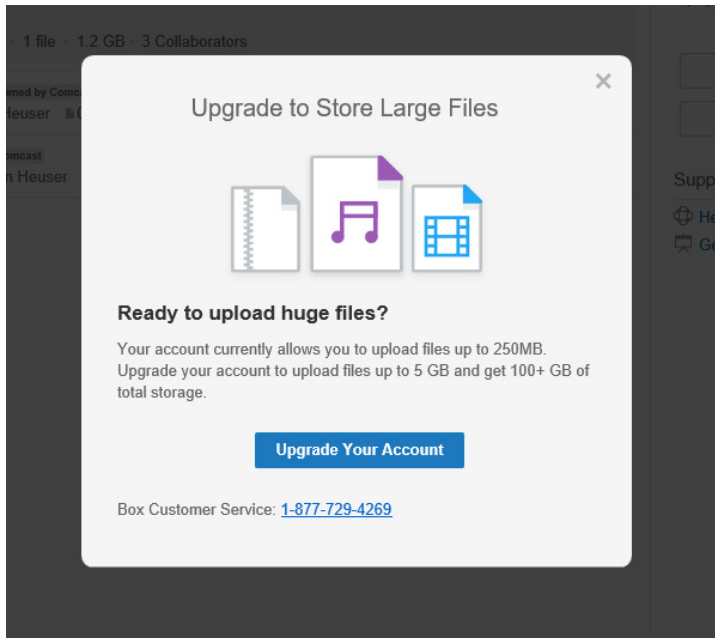
7. You will then be directed back to the main account screen where you will have access to your show folder. Click on your folder to open it up before you begin uploading your shows.



8. You can now start uploading shows. Make sure to always upload within your show folder. If you upload files anywhere else besides this folder, then you will have the limitations of a free Box account, which is 250MB of storage. Since your show folder originated from Comcast, you will have unlimited storage space within it.



9. Be warned, you may receive the following message if you upload a file larger than 250MB to anywhere else other than your designated show folder. There is no need to upgrade your account (unless you really want to).
